60 Robotic surgeries in 6 months



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Robot assisted surgeries are the pinnacle of minimal invasive surgical techniques. The surgical robot adds precision to the surgery thereby increasing the quality and accuracy of surgery. Robotic surgery provides immense benefits to the patients like smaller or invisible scars (no scars), less blood loss, less hospital stay, earlier return to normal activity, better function, earlier completion of treatment, etc.

These benefits are especially seen in cancer surgeries, complex bowel surgeries, gynecological (uterus) surgeries, lung surgeries, pediatric surgeries (surgeries for children) and urological surgeries.

There are multiple robotic surgery systems available in the market. The **da Vinci** Robot (Intuitive Surgical) has been the surgeries leader in robotic for the past 15 years. PSG Super specialty hospital was the first hospital in Coimbatore to get the latest fourth generation **da Vinci** X Robot which is technologically superior to the previous generation robots.

Since the start of the PSG multispecialty Robotic surgery programme in July 2022, the team has completed more than 60 robotic surgeries in within six months period. This is a big achievement for any hospital in Coimbatore region. The multispecialty team includes Dr. K.S.Rajkumar (Cancer Surgeon), Dr. K. Balu (GI Surgeon), Dr. Paavai Arunachalam (Pediatric Surgeon), Dr. Devi (Gynecologist), dedicated specialist Anesthesia team and dedicated robotic operation Theater staff. The patients of all ages from a 4 month old baby to an 82 years old lady have benefited from PSG's Robotic surgery programme.
