FETAL MEDICINE

The Fetal Medicine Unit was established in PSG Hospitals in February 2018. Over the past years the team has worked with care and commitment to provide the highest standard of care for expectant mothers and their unborn babies. The Unit caters to pregnant women from PSG Hospitals and referred from various hospitals in 3-4 surrounding districts thereby strengthening our position as a center of excellence in perinatal care in the region. Our care of the mother begins before pregnancy with pre-conceptional counseling and then from conception, throughout pregnancy forming a continuum of care. The clinical services provided include prenatal screening for aneuploidies (like Down syndrome) and preeclampsia (development of high blood pressure in pregnancy), NT and anomaly scans (advanced fetal scanning to ensure fetal well-being, early and accurate detection of fetal conditions requiring closer monitoring or special care), fetal echocardiography, Doppler, and Growth surveillance. We provide a wide spectrum of interventions like procedures for diagnosis (amniocentesis, chorionic villous sampling, cordocentesis) and therapy (Intrauterine transfusion for fetal anaemia, Laser for Twin to twin transfusion syndrome, selective fetal reduction for higher order multiples, shunting procedures, Radiofrequency and Microwave ablation)



The team of Fetal Medicine Consultants is led by Dr Lalitha N and includes Dr Madhura Kulkarni, Dr Nirupa Daya Dayanand, Dr Aishwarya G and senior Fellows Dr Kavitha and Dr Sharanya

The support staff is a strong team comprising of Mrs Bhuvanapriya, Mrs Nithya, Mrs Reema, Ms Kavya and Ms Nandhini along with Staff Nurse Divya and Senior Attender Kalaivani. They form the backbone of the department and handle multiple roles from appointment scheduling, typing and issuing of reports, assisting in procedures and telephonic communication of results

PSG Emergency Technicians & GOLDEN HOUR

Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) are trained healthcare professionals who provide emergency medical care to patients at the scene of incidents, during transport, and in hospital emergency departments. They are the first responders attending to critically ill patients during the "Golden Hour," working alongside nurses under the supervision of Emergency Medicine Physicians. Their responsibilities include providing pre-hospital and intra-hospital care, attending ambulance calls, stabilizing patients, administering treatments, and maintaining medical equipment. EMTs are skilled in Basic and Advanced Life Support, acute medical care, and pre-hospital management.



VEGAM (Quick Response Medical Service), run by the Department of Emergency Medicine, PSGIMSR, Coimbatore, is a 24x7 community-based service using bike ambulances to reach inaccessible areas within a 20 km radius. It offers rapid response, injury management, sample collection, airway care, and IV medication. EMTs ensure timely, compassionate, and professional emergency care, saving lives before advanced support arrives.

மருத்துவ மாணவர்கள், செவிலியர் மாணவர்கள் மற்றும் பல்வேறு சுகாதார நிபுணர்களுக்கு பாதுகாப்பான சூழலில் நேரடி அனுபவ அடிப்படையிலான பயிற்சிகளை வழங்குகிறது. அன்றாட மருத்துவ நடைமுறைகள் முதல் தீவிர சிகிச்சை செயல்முறைகள் வரை கற்றுக்கொள்ள உதவும் வகையில், இங்கு 100க்கும் மேற்பட்ட மேம்பட்ட தொழில்நுட்ப பயிற்சி மேனிகின்கள் உள்ளன.
